Officer Involved Shooting

At approximately 4:14 pm on Friday, November 1, 2019, an officer from the Schenectady Police Department observed a stolen vehicle on Hulett Street between Albany Street and State Street. The stolen vehicle then pulled into a parking lot on Hulett Street and turned around, driving toward the officer who made the original observation. The officer did discharge his weapon striking the vehicle. At that time the vehicle and its occupants turned Northbound onto Hulett Street where it traveled a short distance, stopping just prior to the intersection of State Street. Both of the occupants of the vehicle then fled on foot. A brief foot pursuit ensued and a 15 year old male was detained a short distance away.

A search of the area was conducted for the additional occupant of the vehicle by members of the Schenectady Police Department, The Schenectady County Sheriff's Department and the New York State Police Aviation Unit, yielding negative results.

At this time the incident is being investigated by members of the Schenectady Police Department's Youth Aid Division and Detective Division. The detained 15 year old male is currently being treated for minor abrasions to his face at a local hospital.
