These training classes will be presented at **no cost to attendees**. Those encouraged to participate include: property owners, landlords, handymen, contractors, maintenance workers, code inspectors, painters, "do it yourselfers", and staff with state and local municipal agencies, community and social service organizations, and professional associations.

The goal of this program is to teach attendees lead-safe work practices and the strategies for implementing them. Many homes built before 1978 contain lead-based paint, so it is important that renovation, remodeling and repair activities use methods that reduce and control dust and debris created during work. Even a small amount of dust can pose a serious health risk to children and families.

These Lead Safe Work Practices trainings are based on EPA's and HUD's previous model courses in lead-safe work practices. This course satisfies HUD requirements for interim controls training in federally assisted housing.

Beginning in April 2010, contractors performing renovation, repair and painting projects that disturb lead-based paint in homes, child care facilities, and schools built before 1978 must be certified and must follow specific work practices to prevent lead contamination. These RRP trainings are taught by an EPA certified training provider.
