### **Schenectady Announces National Grid/Erie Blvd. Work Schedule**

National Grid will commence underground electrical work on Erie Boulevard between I-890 and State Street starting on **Monday, October 11, 2010**. National Grid will be replacing the underground electrical facilities including conduits and manholes. This work will include upgrades to the National Grid electrical system which should improve reliability for all customers along the route as well as for future growth along the Erie Boulevard corridor.

This work is part of four phases of construction that include gas work, civil work, electrical work and customer service work.

The lanes of traffic in both directions will be maintained during all peak traffic hours (between 6 a.m. – 8:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. – 7 p.m.).

The contractor will attempt to maintain the lanes of traffic in both directions at all other times.

There may be work after work hours and on weekends depending on construction activities.

National Grid will try to minimize any inconvenience to the traveling lanes.

This phase of the work should take approximately three (3) months.
