DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This position is responsible for performing semi-skilled sheet metal work in repair and construction of street signs. The work is performed under general supervision from a higher ranking employee. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Makes and repairs metal street signs;
Puts up street signs of all types;
Applies cutting torch in straightening steel posts;
Drives a pick-up truck to transport signs;
Straightens bent signs and meter posts;
Operates air hammer in connection with sign installation;
Helps painters measure and chalk lines;
Performs a variety of related work as required.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Good knowledge of the common practices, tools, terminology and accident precautions of the sheet metal worker's trade; skill as a sheet metal worker; ability to follow oral and written instructions; ability to work from plans and specifications; mechanical aptitude; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- (A) One year of experience in sheet metal or sign maintenance work; OR
- (B) An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by (A) above.
