MAYOR STRATTON ANNOUNCES
***TRICK-OR-TREAT* HOURS FOR SCHENECTADY**

Schenectady Halloween Activities Scheduled Citywide

SCHENECTADY – Mayor Brian U. Stratton today announced that Halloween *Trick-or-Treating* in the City of Schenectady will be officially observed on Wednesday, October 31, 2007 from 3-8 PM. Earlier trick-or-treat hours are provided for younger children.

“Once again, we’re asking trick-or-treaters to conclude their door-to-door visits by 8:00 PM, and for those at home to turn off porch lights and stop handing out goodies at that time as well,” Mayor Stratton said. “Above all, we want to ensure that everyone has a safe and happy Halloween.”

The Schenectady Fire Department will have candy and Halloween Activity books available at each station, from 4 – 7 PM or until the candy runs out. The Goose Hill Neighborhood Association has donated over 350 individual bags of candy to Station #4, and the Fire Department is supplying the rest of the candy.

The locations are:

- Fire Station #1 – 360 Veeder Avenue
- Fire Station #2 – 1515 State Street
- Fire Station #3 – 1200 Third Avenue
- Fire Station #4 – 1549 Avenue A

In addition, the Schenectady Police Department will be handing out candy from 4 – 7 PM at its community Traffic Division office, 837 Albany Street.
