

Mayor McCarthy Announces Success of Schenectady's HOMES Program

Over \$2.5 million in Owner Occupied Homes Since July 2013

SCHENECTADY óMayor Gary R. McCarthy today was joined by City officials and other Home Ownership Made Easy in Schenectady (HOMES) partners to announce the success of the program. Since July 2013, over forty former City-owned properties are now owner occupied homes, encompassing over two and half million dollars in value.

oln the past several years, we changed the way we sell City owned property and implemented a deliberate, professional system that promotes owner occupancy,ö said Mayor Gary McCarthy. olimproving owner occupancy rates helps improve neighborhoods and we are dedicated to helping people find the best path to home ownership and opportunity. The HOMES program improves quality of life in our City and we are proud of its continued success.ö

Officials spoke in front of 955 Helderberg Avenue, recently purchased by Schenectady small business owner Everado Sosa-Mendoza. In 2010 Sosa-Mendozaøs family and he decided to start their own business and opened a small Mexican grocery store, La Mexicana at 1759 State Street. One year later, Mr. Sosa-Mendoza and his family expanded the store to include a successful neighborhood restaurant that serves traditional Mexican food.

I saw that this house was for sale, and thought that it would be great to fix up this home and move my family here,ö said Everado Sosa-Mendoza. õWe are excited and thankful that the city agreed to sell us the house, and I am looking forward to improving this home and becoming a part of this neighborhood with my family.ö
