Emmett Street Shots Fried incident (update)

In regards to the shots fired incident that occurred yesterday at 931 Emmett Street, the male who was detained has now been formally charged by Schenectady Police Detectives. That male has been identified as Tysean Bell, 31 years old, of Brooklyn. Mr. Bell has been charged with the following:

Criminal Possession of a weapon 2nd Degree	(2 counts)	(Class C Felony)
Criminal Use of a firearm 2nd Degree		(Class C Felony)
Attempted Assault 1st Degree		(Class B Felony)
Menacing 2nd Degree		(Class A Misdemeanor)

Mr. Bell was arraigned this morning in Schenectady City court by the sitting Magistrate and is currently in the care and custody of the Schenectady County Sherriff's Department.
