

Citizen Participation Plan Amendment for Covid-19 Response

In an effort to respond effectively and safely to the Covid-19 Pandemic, The City of Schenectady has made the following Amendments to its Citizen Participation Plan per guidance from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD):

- In response to Memorandum issued on April 1, 2020 by HUD in regards to “Availability of Waivers of Community Planning and Development (CPD) Grant Program and Consolidated Plan Requirements to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19 and Mitigate Economic Impacts Caused by COVID-19,” The City of Schenectady has amended its Citizen Participation Plan to allow for a 5 day Public Comment Period instead of the normal 30 day Public Comment Period for Substantial Amendments to the Consolidated Plan as related to COVID-19.
- In accordance with, New York State Governor Andrew Cuomo’s Executive Order No. 202 issued on March 7, 2020, the City of Schenectady’s Public Comments will be submitted remotely to CommunityDevelopment@schenectadyny.gov. All public comments will be made available to the public at the close of the public comment period. All Public Comments shall be posted to the City of Schenectady’s Website at the end of the Public Comment Period.
