

## **City of Schenectady Notice of Public Comment Period for Utilization of CARES Act HUD Funding**

In response to the Coronavirus Pandemic (COVID-19), the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has allocated \$619,061 in stimulus funding through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV-3) to the City of Schenectady. This allocation is authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136.

The City of Schenectady requests public comment from residents within the community on the proposed allocations of CDBG-CV-3 funds outlined. This information will also be made available online at <https://www.cityofschenectady.com/195/Development>.

The City of Schenectady continues to work with our partners, service providers and community to identify the most immediate needs and projected long-term needs as result of COVID-19 in order to align these resources in a timely manner to the highest priorities identified.

A Public Comment Period will begin on Tuesday, November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 8:00 AM and conclude on Monday, November 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 at 4:00 PM.
